## The Young Irish Artists Foundation

Early in 1965 Mr. C. J. Lytle generously agreed to finance a new project aimed to help young artists. His idea was to draw attention to those young people who having survived the period of training decide to become full scale professionals. Mr. Lytle believes that if young men and women are going to be a success then their work produced before the age of 27 ought to show some indication of the fact. For this reason we hit on the idea of selecting specific examples of work and offering it to the public in an exhibition for sale.

This exhibition then is the result of the first year's selection. For every work on view the artist received £25 as a temporary acquisition fee. In addition to this the Foundation organises the exhibitions in Belfast, Cork and Dublin and offers the works to the public. The full purchase price will be paid to the artist without deduction of commission and the Foundation has purchased three works outright which it will present to Irish art galleries.

We draw the attention of the public to the fact that the works have been carefully selected by experts. We very much hope that collectors will respond to Mr. Lytle's generous patronage and show their confidence in the future by purchasing the works here displayed.

It may sound extravagant to say that a country depends on its creative artists for the ideas and stimulation which will give rise to new shapes in architecture, new objects in industry and new currents of thought everywhere. Yet if we read history we find that almost every great invention was first blue-printed by some artist. Ireland is no exception. We cannot afford to ignore our artists or leave them in isolation. Let us all join in recognising the importance of the lead now given to us by Mr. C. J. Lytle.
